RADIATION THERAPY PRIVILEGES

Privilege Guidelines

___ Acceptance as a physician into the faculty of the Radiation Therapy Division of the Department of Radiation Oncology implies completion of an ACGME accredited program, or its equivalent, in therapeutic Radiology and accepted physicians are accorded practice privileges in Therapeutic Radiology within the Department of Radiation Oncology. This includes the supervision and/or performance of teletherapy, brachytherapy, and hyperthermia as indicated below.

In exigent circumstances, such "privileges" shall not proscribe the performance of such procedures by trained but "non-privileged" individuals.

Specific Privileges

- ___ 1. External Beam Radiotherapy
- ___ 2. Radiosurgery
- ___ 3. Surface Brachtherapy with 90 Strontium
- ___ 4. Intracavitary Brachytherapy including 137 Cesium or 32 Phosphorus
- ___ 5. Interstitial Brachytherapy including 192 Iridium, 125 Iodine and 107 Paladium
- ___ 6. High Dose Rate Brachytherapy
- ___ 7. Hyperthermia
