The University of Utah School on Alcoholism and Other Drug Dependencies agrees to assign space for this educational activity according to the following terms, conditions and requirements:

1. Space (3' X 6' clothed banquet table or equivalent floor space) will be leased for the duration of this educational activity to (check whichever applies):
 - Commercial organizations: \$500.00
 - Non-commercial organizations (including government and community organizations and specialty societies): \$250.00

The exhibit area will be available for setting-up exhibits beginning at noon on Sunday, June 15, 2008. The exhibit area will be open Monday through Wednesday, June 16-18, 2008, 8:00–5:00 p.m. Registration will be on Sunday, June 15, from 3:00 – 7:00 p.m. and you may exhibit during that time also. If you wish, you may also exhibit on Thursday and Friday morning, June 19 and 20. Any display material not removed by 1:00 p.m. on Friday June 20, will be discarded. General Sessions lectures will be held Monday 9:00-12:00 noon and Wednesday and Friday 11:00-12:00 noon in the ballroom adjacent to the display area. During these times, exhibits need to shut down in order to not interfere with the General Sessions lectures.

2. All exhibits will be held in the Union Building, Ballroom Corridor.
3. Fire laws will be strictly observed. Aisles and fire exits cannot be blocked by tables, cables, boxes or other items.
4. We cannot guarantee exhibitors against loss or damage of any kind, but will endeavor to protect the exhibit area according to standard security protection.
5. Exhibitors agree to refrain from pasting, nailing or otherwise attaching signs or other display materials to walls, doors, backdrops, floors and carpets or other in any way that mars or defaces them. Any damages to the surfaces will be paid for by the exhibitor.
6. Exhibits should not project beyond the space allocation and should not obstruct the view of or interfere with other exhibits.

7. To avoid infringing on others, all interviews, demonstrations, distribution of literature, sales promotions and other similar activities should be conducted at the exhibitor's table.
8. Exhibits producing noise or other interference which is not adequately controlled will be relocated to reduce such interference.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for arranging for electrical hook-ups and AV needs and providing their own extension cords.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for removing exhibits at the end of the activity. Material not removed by 1:00 p.m., Friday, June 20, will be discarded.
11. Special written agreement must be made in advance if two or more companies or groups wish to exhibit in a single space.
12. In order to receive a refund, written notice of cancellation must be made at least seven days prior to the beginning of this activity.
13. Other than for educational materials, direct sales involving the exchange of funds in the exhibit areas by any exhibitor or their agent is prohibited.
14. We make all space assignments without preconditions and reserve the right to rearrange the floor plan and to relocate any exhibitor's space.
15. Infractions of these terms and conditions on the part of the exhibitor or representative may result in dismissal from the exhibit area.
16. Space is leased with the understanding that The University of Utah assumes no liability whatsoever for damages resulting from any act of omission or commission in connection with the exhibition of products and services. The exhibitor and its representative hereby release The University of Utah from any or all liabilities for loss associated with this rental of table top space, ensuing from any cause whatsoever.
17. Full payment and signed contract must be received by **May 15, 2008**, in order to activate the contract. **Checks should be made payable and mailed to:**

We cannot be responsible for materials you ship directly to the Union Building.
